



## TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN OZARK CHRISTIAN COLLEGE AND MISSOURI SOUTHERN STATE UNIVERSITY

This agreement is made and entered into by and between Ozark Christian College (OCC) and Missouri Southern State University (MSSU).

Missouri Southern State University will offer degree completion studies for students to earn a Bachelor of Arts in Bible and Interdisciplinary Studies degree from Ozark Christian College. Students can be dually enrolled at each institution. This agreement applies to students pursuing the Bachelor of Arts in Bible and Interdisciplinary Studies Degree at OCC in addition to any other degree at MSSU.

### TERMS

This Agreement shall commence on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2018, and will terminate on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2019. However, the agreement will be extended for successive one (1) year terms unless canceled by prior written notice from either party at least 60 days in advance of the annual expiration date.

This agreement is subject to revision as curriculum changes at either institution. All proposed revisions will be submitted in writing for approval by both parties. Details regarding course transferability will be maintained on the MSSU website Transfer Guide Page.

Students need to apply to each institution and fulfill the application requirements for each institution.

Students enrolled in the Dual Degree Program must sign the OCC/MSSU Dual Enrollment Agreement authorizing each institution to share enrollment verification, grade reports, official transcripts, or any other information the institutions deem necessary.

### FINANCIAL AID

Students enrolled in the Dual Degree Program at OCC and MSSU will receive Financial Aid from the school they are attending on a full-time basis. A Consortium Agreement will be used to administer financial aid awards when a student is not full-time at either school during a term.

### SCHOLARSHIPS

MSSU scholarships will be available to students only when enrolled on a full-time basis at MSSU. Continued scholarship eligibility requires a student to meet scholarship renewal criteria and consecutive full-time enrollment at MSSU.

Transfer scholarship applications will be accepted from dually enrolled students upon full-time enrollment at MSSU. The cumulative combined Grade Point Average (GPA) will be used to award

scholarships. Previous enrollment at MSSU will not disqualify a dually enrolled student from being eligible for a transfer scholarship.
