Position Summary

This person will be responsible for implementing the small group program at Christian Fellowship Church, serving as a champion for the ministry, and the primary point of contact for small group leaders and those wishing to join a small group. They will also oversee CFC's men's ministry, fostering a culture of discipleship among the men of CFC.

Primary Functions

- Serve as primary contact for small group leaders and coaches
- Recruit and facilitate training for new small group leaders
- Serve as a resource for small group leaders with difficult small group situations
- Serve as primary contact for individuals interested in joining a small group
- Maintain accurate records of small group membership, details, and attendance
- Assist in creation of weekly discussion guides for sermon-based small groups
- Assist with curating recommended resources for use by small groups
- Organize and facilitate one-on-one mentoring among members of CFC desiring a mentoring relationship

Secondary Functions

- Assist with volunteer training through teaching and mentoring
- All other duties as assigned by Adult Ministry Team Leader
- Oversee men's ministry, fostering a culture of discipleship among the men of CFC

Qualifications

- Strong interpersonal skills
- Experience serving/leading in a small group ministry
- Humble, coachable, and teachable. A team player with a heart for ministry
- Ability to recruit, train, and manage a large volunteer team
- Ability to utilize ministry-related software to organize and facilitate a healthy and growing ministry environment
- Bible College or Seminary degree preferred
- A personal and growing relationship with Jesus
