Student Minister

Purpose

The Student Minister's main goals are to exemplify a desire to follow Christ to students, partner with parents in developing a Christian worldview for students, promote spiritual disciplines, and set an example of servant leadership. The Student Minister is responsible for training, equipping, and assisting volunteers in all aspects of the student ministry program (Middle School & High School; 6th-12th grades).

Qualifications

- The Student Minister must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ evident through personal growth that results from Bible reading, prayer, community, and service.
- The Student Minister should bear the visible fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23).
- The Student Minister must believe and teach in agreeance to Biblical doctrine found in our *What We Believe* statement, which is attached to this job description.
- The Student Minister must be willing to join and work well with a team of other faculty/staff members (this includes, but is not limited to, the Senior Minister, Children's Minister, Administrative Assistants, Elders, Ministry Leaders, and volunteers).
- The Student Minister should be a self-starter, creative, professional, and should exercise discernment in matters of confidentiality.

Job Duties

- The primary programs for which this position is responsible are **High School Youth Group** (which meets from 5:30-7:00p on Sundays during the school year) and **Middle School Youth Group** (which meets from 5:30-7:00p on Wednesdays during the school year). The Student Minister is responsible for organizing Youth Group, leading as the main speaker/teacher, and equipping volunteers to help lead small groups and disciple students.
- The Student Minister will be present on Sunday mornings. This includes First Service at 8:00a, Sunday School at 9:00a, and Second Service at 10:00a. This position would be encouraged to teach either Middle or High School Sunday school and serve in other areas as gifts/desires match-up.
- This ministry is equal parts teaching/leading of students and administration/organization of faculty.
- The Student Minister will be expected to participate in, lead, and organize events such as church camp (Shelby County Christian Assembly), Nationwide Youth Roundup, etc.
- The Student Minister will seek ways to be a face/voice in the community including, but not limited to, extracurricular school events and milestone moments.
- The Student Minister will work alongside current staff and Ministry Leaders to set/operate the budget for the student ministry program.
- This Student Minister will be accountable to the elders of Shelbina Christian Church and will work under the supervision of the Senior Minister.
