



Youth Ministry Intern

Overview

Bentonville Community Church (BCC) has a dynamic and growing youth ministry in downtown Bentonville (AR), and we are looking for someone to partner with a committed team of volunteers and parents to lead this group of students in the 2022-23 academic year. The intern will primarily be focused on creating meaningful Wednesday night worship experiences in which young people encounter God, learn more about His Word, grow deeper in their relationships with one another, and are sent to be a light in their schools, families, neighborhoods, and friend groups.



This paid internship will provide the opportunity for teaching/preaching to students on Wednesday nights. The intern will also work with the youth volunteers to coordinate some relationship-building and outreach activities throughout the year. A weekend retreat is planned for the fall. On Sunday mornings, the intern will serve as a resource to the youth discipleship teacher and build relationships with families with students.



Competency

High School Diploma plus some college credit required. The exceptional candidate will be a junior or senior in college pursuing a calling in vocational ministry.

Responsibilities

- Teach/Preach to students (7-12th) on Wednesday nights (Aug-Nov; Jan-May)
- Collaborate with youth worship team to plan Wednesday night service
- Coordinate outreach activities/fellowship events with the BCC Youth Ministry Team
- Manage online curriculum for small group leaders (GROW)
- Build relationships with students

Remuneration

Pay is based on experience and skill with starting offers at \$1,000 a month, plus a fuel stipend for 2 trips per week to the church. Additionally, a modest expense account for entertainment and ministry related books/resources is included.
